

The resolutions of the representatives of the European Parasitological Societies passed on 14-th of November in Jablonna /near Warsaw/

After the idea of forming an European Society had aroused and was circulated by a letter of the president of the Polish Society of Parasitologists of July 28-th ,1966,the representatives of the Polish Society of Parasitologists,British Society for Parasitologists, British Society for Parasitology,Societe belge de Parasitologie, Hungarian Society for Parasitology,Parasitologische Gesellschaft der DDR, Parasitological Society of Cechoslovakia, Българска Bulgarian Society for Parasitology, and Netherlands Society for Parasitology decide in their meeting in Jablonna near Warsaw on 14 November 1966 to form an European Federation of Parasitologists. The aims of the EFP are to promote cooperation between European parasitologists by means of the organization of symposia, to give appropriate advices to government agencies, and to promote temporary exchange of parasitologists.

It is a particular aim of the EFP to be a member of and a support to the the World Federation of Parasitologists.
